



Education & Scholarship:

- ➤ Graduates high school on Dec. 1, 2022 in Medellin
- ➤ He passed four grades in a little over a year
- Antioquia state and Medellin government sports institutions offered him a *full-scholarship*. This includes housing, food, and transport to some events.

Track & Field Events:

- Qualifying event for the Juegos Nacionales that will be held in Nov 2023.
- > 100 meters: with a time of 16' 46" (competed alone) this is down from his obest time of 20' prior to the event.
- Shot Put: distance 7m 27cm with 6kl ball 8th place
- ➤ Javelin: distance 33m27cm 3rd place
- Next steps: Juegos Nacionales (which he recently qualified for) in Nov. 2023. At this event, he will attempt to qualify for the Paralympics (París 2024).

- Began on August 6th.
- He has worked with Project Beisbol on projects for six years while he worked for the Colombian Ministry of Foreign Affairs as the Sport Diplomacy Manager.
- During his 10 years at the Ministry, he led 152 exchanges in 52 countries with over 2000 young athletes in approximately 20 sports.
- Developed strong relationships at all levels of government in Colombia and an advanced ability to navigate bureaucracies.
- ➤ He has a strong relationship with the new Gustavo Petro administration in Colombia, which will pay off big in the near future.
- > fully bi-lingual, and an excellent diplomat, community organizer, and orator in both languages.









The MLBPAA (Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association) together with Project Béisbol led three high-impact baseball clinics for youth ballplayers and baseball coaches in Medellín, Cúcuta and Bogotá from November 4-7, 2022. Project Beisbol made generous equipment donations during these events. They were led by five active and retired professional MLB and MiLB players.
